These words from a famous Vietnamese song capture the essence of the DNC Social welfare club, a faculty-led organization at Nam Can Tho University that aims to help people in difficult circumstances. The club recently showed their compassion and generosity by donating 15 million VND (about 650 USD) to a cardiac patient who could not afford her treatment.

The patient, T.U, is a 66-year-old woman of Khmer ethnicity who lives in a rural area of Kien Giang Province. She suffers from a serious heart condition that requires urgent medical intervention. She was admitted to the Department of Cardiology and Cardiovascular Intervention at Nam Can Tho University Hospital on August 9, 2023, but her family had no means to pay for the costly procedure. They had to borrow money from various sources, but it was still not enough.
